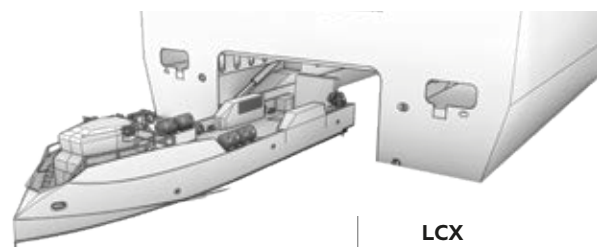
## LANDING CRAFT X MISSIONS
